The Weather...

April was a month of large contrasts in the weather. It was cold, rainy, and windy, and we had practically a whole week where flying was not possible. This was due to solid IFR conditions with icing. Toward the end of the month the temperatures then soared into the 80's, but soon fell back to the usual. Because of the delay in more mild temperatures the birds are running a little behind schedule in building their nests. The time will arrive soon, however! Make sure you conduct a thorough preflight inspection just in case...

Special Of The Month

Receive a checkout in our new Cessna 172SP for an aircraft rate of \$110 per hour. This special rate is limited to 3 hours in the aircraft. Instructor rate and fuel surcharge is additional.

The rental rate for Warrior 2159H has been lowered to \$100.00 per hour. Fuel surcharge is additional. Keep in mind that it is a VFR aircraft only and is neither equipped nor certified for IFR flight.

Reminder...

*Please remember to remove covers prior to flight and replace the cover **TIGHTLY** after each flight. Covers not tightly installed can blow away with the wind.*
