The company policy states that you must give us 18 hours notice for cancelled dual lesson, otherwise a \$57 fee will be incurred. 30 minutes is simply not enough notice! Thank you.

Overnight Rentals

If you have been given permission to rent an aircraft overnight the renter is responsible for all fees involved during the time that he/she has the aircraft. This includes parking fees, landing fees, hangar fees, and customs stickers (if you are flying outside of the U.S.). BFC will reimburse the renter for fuel purchased at other airports, however reimbursement will not exceed the current price per gallon at KBVY (presently \$5.89 per gallon). Fuel prices vary considerably, especially if you venture into Canada where fuel prices can be as high as \$8.00 per gallon!
