Winter...

We are now in the heart of winter. So far we have been treated to plenty of freezing rain, snow, cold temperatures, wind. Please take extra care when taxiing in the winter. As always, taxi slowly. Watch wingtip clearances very carefully with any existing snowbanks. Taxiing on the yellow line does not always guarantee adequate space when snowbanks exist! Avoid taxiing over ice chunks as they may cause damage to the tires and the propeller. Avoid performing runups on icy surfaces and always verify that the aircraft does not slide when power is applied. Hopefully the warm weather is not too far off. Think spring!

We handle his scheduling, so give us a call when you are due.
