Our New Cessna 172S...

Cessna has refined their 172S to achieve new levels of interior quietness and comfort giving you more luxury, more performance, and more value. This aircraft is equipped with a factory-installed Garmin G-1000 avionics suite whose characteristics include two large color displays, onboard weather services, a terrain warning system, and a traffic alerting system. The aircraft is also equipped with a King autopilot.

The rental checkout for this aircraft

entails the following:

VFR:

Ground Training:

- 1.) Elements of the C-172S and its associated systems.
- 2.) Review of differences in procedures between aircraft equipped with the G-1000 and those equipped with a standard avionics package.
- 3.) Elements of the G-1000 system, the PFD and MFD menus and functions, and operation of radio and audio functions.

Flight Training:

- 1.) Minimum of one flight to perform basic flight maneuvers and to gain familiarization with basic functions of the G-1000 primary flight display (PFD).
- 2.) Minimum of one flight to perform more advanced G-1000 functions including navigation and use of the multi-function flight display (MFD).

IFR:

- 1.) All of the above for VFR
- 2.) Minimum of one flight to demonstrate IFR operations and instrument approaches using the G-1000.
