### The Three H's...

Hazy, Hot, and Humid days are here for the next few months. The temperatures in July and August will get into the nineties and with that will arrive hazy conditions and high density altitude: two factors very important for pilots to consider prior to flight. The visibility can often be 3 to 5 statute miles, but keep in mind that this is still legal VFR. If you have not experienced such conditions, however, make arrangements to have a lesson with an instructor first before venturing out on your own. Also keep in mind that 3 to 5 statute miles reported on the surface may be considerably less at altitude. Consult the aircraft performance charts to determine aircraft performance, especially if you are operating with heavy loads.

### Multi-Engine Aircraft

BFC is looking to add a new multi-engine trainer to our fleet to replace the Piper Seneca that we sold last fall. This time around we plan on purchasing a 4-seat Piper Seminole. One more fractional owner is needed to purchase the aircraft, however. If anyone is interested in purchasing a share in this aircraft please contact Arne. You need not be multi-engine rated in advance.
