Back Up And Running...

Our two C-172's, N13151 and N1418V, are both back to flying after having their engines overhauled. The engines will require a break-in period during which time relatively high, constant power settings must be maintained for as long as feasible. This means that no touch-and-go's, stop-and-go's, intentional go-arounds, slow flight, stalls, or any other maneuvers involving rapid and large power changes may be performed for the first 25 hours after the overhaul. Also, only mineral oil may be used during this period.

New Airplane...

BFC has just acquired a brand new 2006 Piper Warrior III, N3152K. It is equipped with dual Garmin GNS 430's. No special checkout is required, however anyone wishing to rent this aircraft must be competent in using the GNS 430 and must hold a Private Pilot certificate. The aircraft will be used primarily for instrument rating training and for cross-country flying.

Seminar...

Instructor Greg Woo will be holding an Avidyne Entegra seminar on Saturday, November 3rd at 12:30p. Keep in mind that this seminar is part of the checkout requirement for anyone wishing to fly our new Archer III. The cost will be \$50 per person. Space is limited, so please sign up.

New Training Tool...

We now have an external power pack for our new Archer III. This will allow for ground training and practice with the Avidyne Entegra glass cockpit system without actually flying the aircraft! The rental charge for the unit is only \$10.00 per hour. Rent it for "solo" practice, or schedule an instructor for the additional instructor rate.

Runway 9/27...

The Runway 9/27 opening, which was scheduled for late-October, has been delayed yet again. According to the airport manager, the opening will occur in mid-Novemeber. So...be patient, and in the meantime continue practicing those crosswind takeoffs and landings!
