Landing Fees...

Several popular airports used by BFC customers are now charging landing fees and/or parking fees. When an aircraft lands at one of these airports the tail number is recorded and the registered owner is sent a bill in the mail. These bills sometimes take up to three months to be delivered. BFC then passes the bill along to the customer who rented the aircraft. Below is a list of airports and their fees:

- Lawrence (LW M): \$10 parking
- Bedford (BED): Minimum \$10; more at night
- Martha's Vinyard, MA (MVY)
- Nantucket, MA (ACK)
- Manchester, NH (MHT)
- Bridgeport, CT (BDR)
- Westchester, NY (HPN)
- Teterboro, NJ (TEB)
- East Hampton, NY (HTO)
